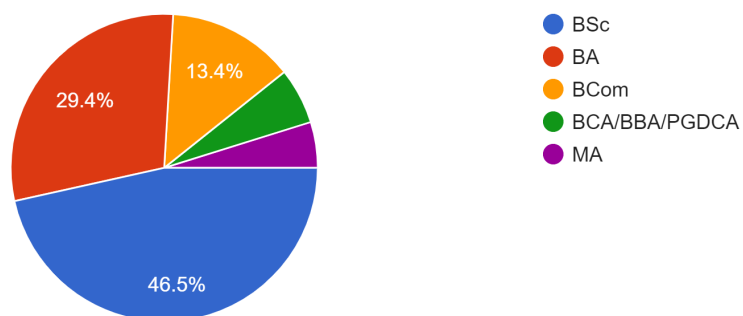


Student Satisfaction Survey (2019-20 analysis:

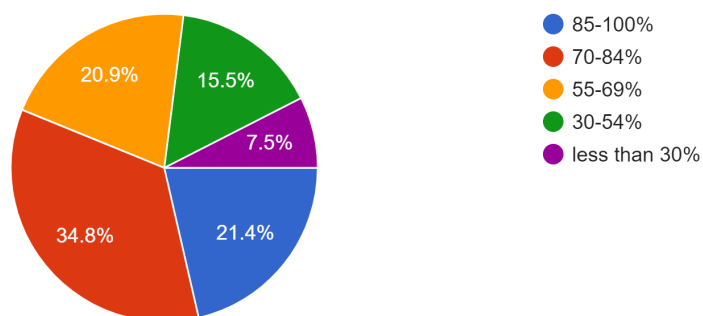
What degree program are you pursuing now?

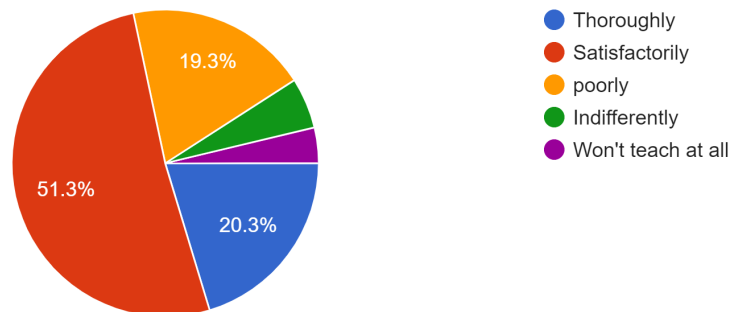
How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

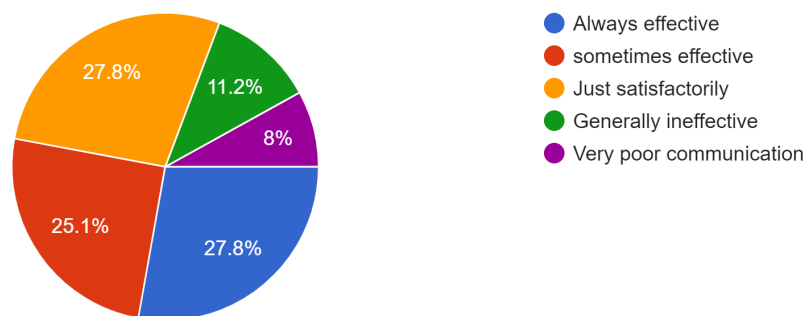
How well did the teachers prepare for class?

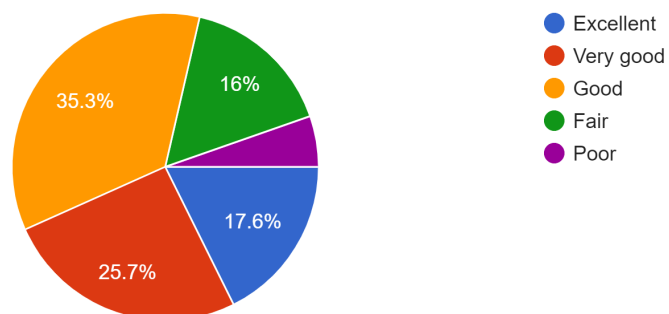
How well were the teachers able to communicate?

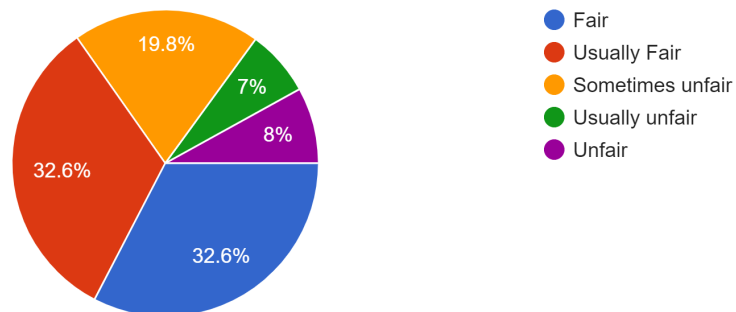
The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as:

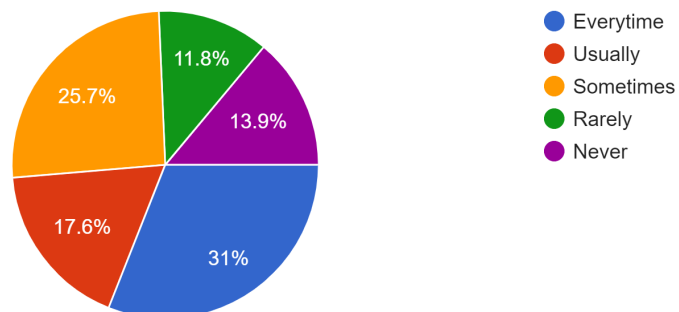
Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers

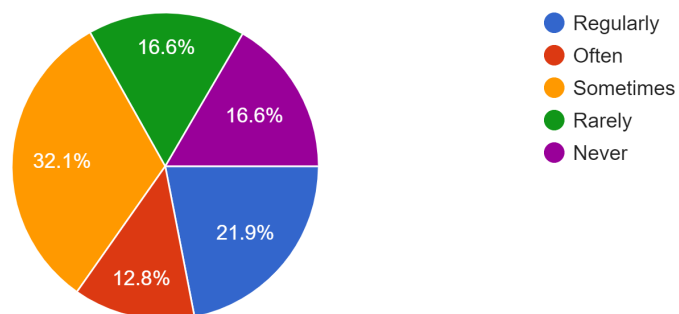

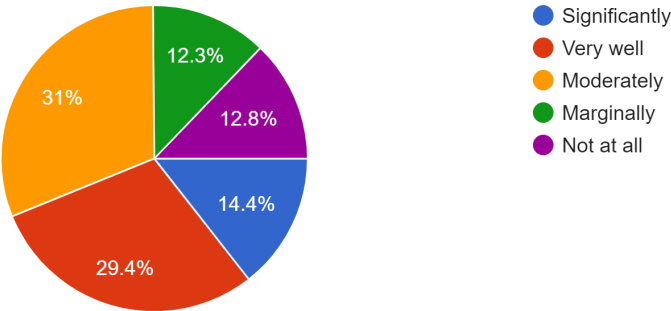

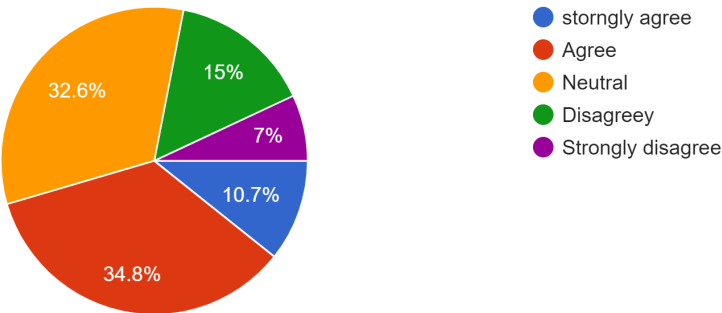
The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth

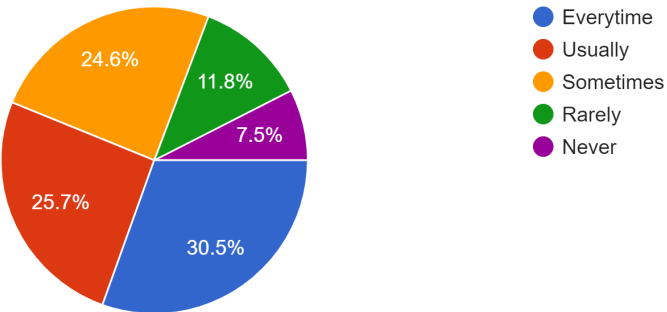

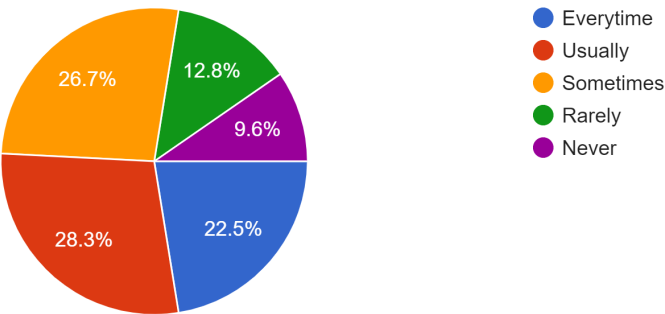


Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes

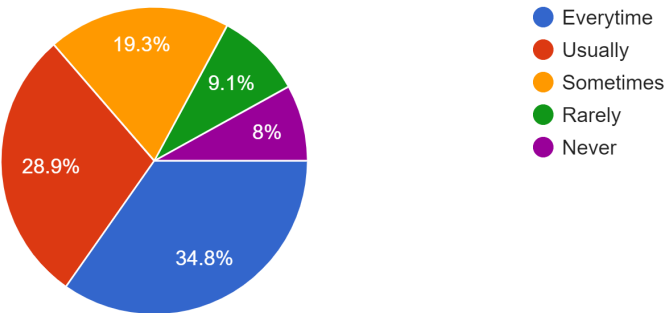

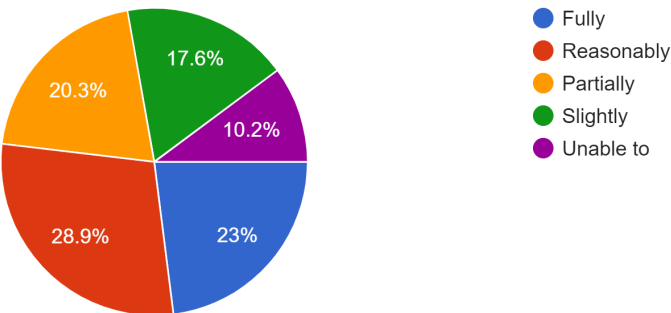

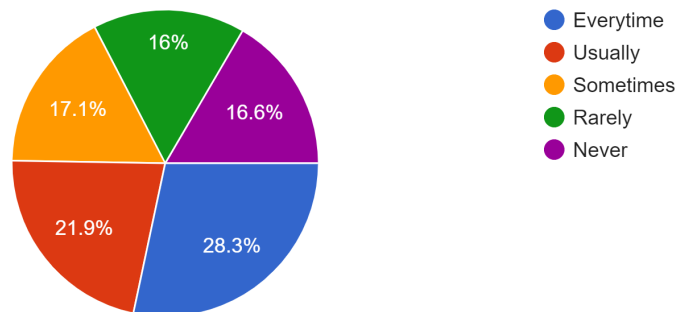

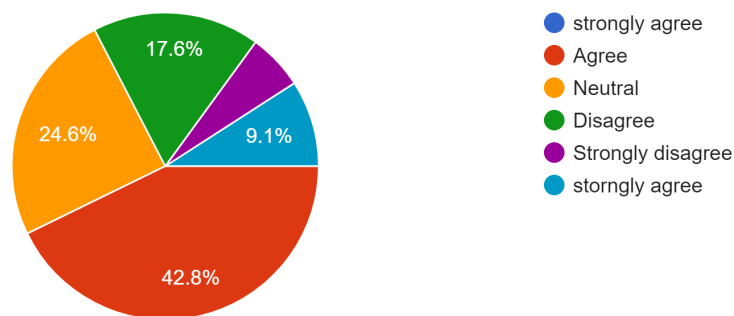

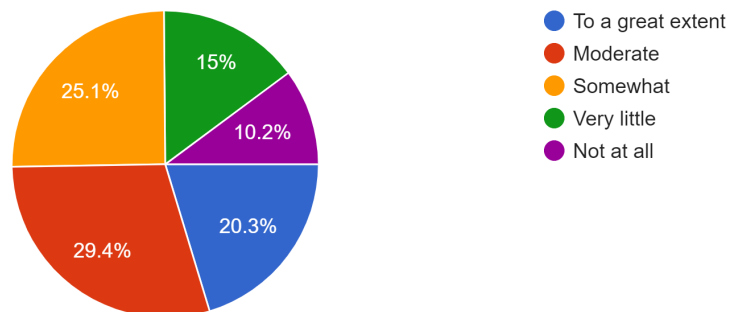

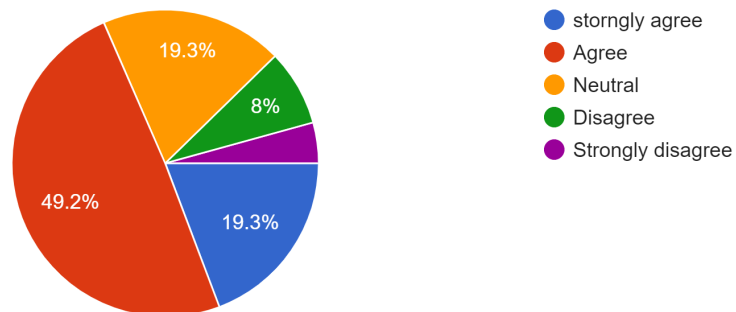

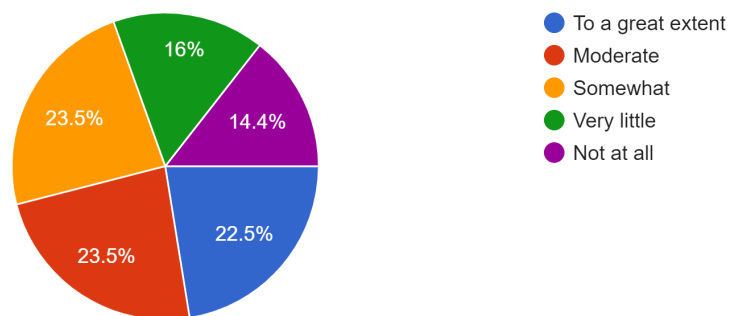

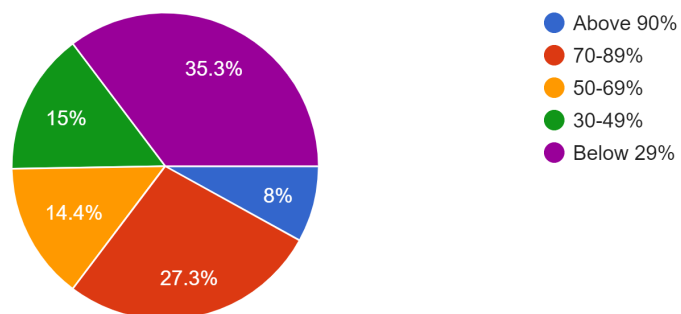
Efforts are made by the institute/teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills, employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.

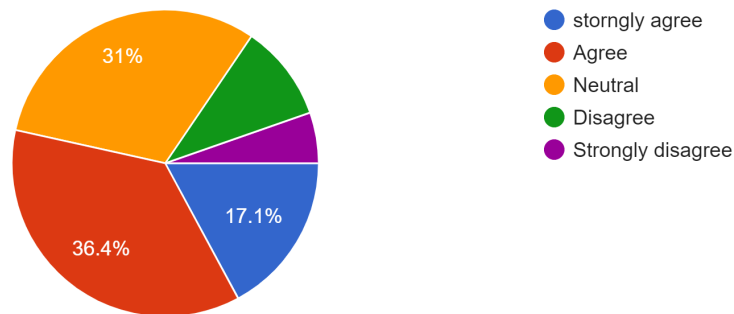
What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia, online resources for teaching.
